Virtual Vaccine Town Hall: moving to tier Phase 1B on Saturday: teachers, food and agriculture workers, emergency workers will be vaccinated next

Currently 22 000 vaccines have been administered per day

The County's Emergency Rental Assistance Program will open on Tuesday providing the rent and utilities assistance
