### **SVTC Meeting Minutes**

President Lil Nover called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

#### **Agenda:**

1. Lil made a motion to approve the agenda. Julia seconded and all voted Yes to approve.
2. Lil made a motion to approve the January meeting minutes, Wayne seconded and all voted Yes to approve.
3. Lil made a motion to approve the February special meeting minutes, Wayne seconded and all voted Yes to approve.
4. Julia gave an update on the progress of the SVTC Annual Financial Report
5. Lil gave an overview of the Recreation Advisory Group meeting and Clairemont Town Council meeting.
6. Luis Pallera gave an update on Plaza Sorrento shopping mall (discount grocery chain ALDI will be an anchor of the mall). He also spoke about new scooter regulations including new speed limitations and updated parking regulations.

7. Wayne gave an update on the SD Marijuana report and the Pure Water SD project. Within SD City, 39 of 40 marijuana dispensaries have been approved, and 5 are located in Sorrento Valley, 13 in Mira Mesa, and 4 in Torrey Pines neighborhood.

Pure Water is a multi-year, 3-phase project that starts with a facility at Eastgate Mall and ends at Miramar Lake. The traffic on Miramar road will be affected for at least a year.

8. Julia gave an update on her research of the potential re-zoning areas in Sorrento Valley.
